

Scholarship Qualifications

The first consideration will be given to the PacifiCorp fallen employees' family members described as:

- a. Legal spouse at time of death until remarried
- b. Biological and legally adopted children

The second consideration will be given to PacifiCorp disabled employees' family members described as:

- a. Legal spouse at time of disabled retirement
- b. Biological and legally adopted children

The third consideration will be given to PacifiCorp regular full-time or retired employees' family members described as:

a. Biological or legally adopted children or grandchildren

Qualifying Student Status:

a. Students enrolled in 12 credit hours (full-time) are preferred, although consideration may be given to those who are enrolled as less than full-time

Grade Point Average:

a. Student should have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and must provide a current transcript of grades

School Type:

a. Must be an accredited college or technical trade school

Scholarships will be paid directly to the educational institution:

a. Special consideration may be given for book allowances if requested by the scholarship recipient, and if approved by the Board of Trustees, payment will be made directly to the book vendor

b. Any tuition refunds will be returned to PEMSF

Necessity and income may be considered for qualification.

You may be required to submit proof of accreditation for the school you plan to attend.

The scholarship may not be paid if any of the above requirements are not met.
